Purpose of homework

The setting of formal and informal homework is seen to be important in developing the following:

- time management skills
- organisational skills
- the consolidation of knowledge and skills learnt in class
- independent learning
- the ability to prioritise tasks

General Guidelines

1. A reasonable amount of formal homework will be set for all students.

Years 7-8 – 3 hours per week.

Years 9-10 – 4 hours per week.

Year 11 – 8 hours per week (unless doing a Year 12 subject)

- 2. A reasonable period of time will be allowed for completing it.
- 3. Parents are requested to check homework is done at home and to give reasonable help when necessary.
- 4. Homework needs to be the independent work of the student. Copying of other students' work will be heavily penalised.
- 5. Teacher will check, acknowledge and record completed homework.
- 6. The Student Diary will be used by parents and teachers to record information about homework.
- 7. Teacher will expect students to finish off work or to catch up missed work from time to time.
- 8. Teachers will give an indication of the approximate time a homework task will take.
- 9. Parents and students may request additional homework or study activities in any subject and teachers will arrange it.
- 10. If homework is not done by the due date without an adequate reason then the work will be done in detention classes (individual teachers may deduct marks for late work).
- 11. No homework will be set during term holidays and public holidays for students in Years 7 -10.
